Applications are invited online through the proforma Application form to be made available on the WEBSITE (<http://opsconline.gov.in>) from **13.04.2015 to 12.05.2015** (Note: **14.05.2015 is the last date for payment of application fees**) for recruitment to 33(thirty three) posts of Lecturers in different disciplines in Government Homoeopathic Medical Colleges of the State in Class-II (Group-B) under Health & Family Welfare Department in the scale of pay of Rs.9300-34800/- carrying Grade Pay of Rs.4600/- with usual Dearness and other Allowances as may be sanctioned by the Government of Odisha from time to time.

On line application must be followed by submission of Hard copy of the same along with copies of certificates by the last date i.e on **25.05.2015**.

2. VACANCY POSITION:

The candidates are required to submit one application indicating therein their option for allied subjects (Sl.No. 5 to 12).

- (a) In the event of non-availability or availability of insufficient number of eligible women candidates belonging to any particular category, the vacancies or remaining vacancies will be filled up by male candidates of that category.
- (b) Exchange of reservation between Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe will not be considered.
- (c) The number of vacancies to be filled up on the basis of this recruitment is subject to change by Government without notice, depending upon the exigencies of public service.
- (d) The posts are temporary, and likely to be made permanent. The period of probation is two years. The appointment can be terminated on one month's notice from either side without assigning any reason thereof.

3. **AGE:**

A candidate must not be under the age of 21 (twenty one) years and must not be above the age of 32 (thirty two) years as on the 1st day of January, 2015 i.e he/she must not have been born earlier than 2nd January 1983 & not later than 1st January 1994.

The upper age limit is relaxable by 5 (five) years for candidates belonging to the categories of Scheduled Castes (S.C.), Scheduled Tribes (S.T.), Socially & Educationally Backward Classes (S.E.B.C.), Women, Ex-servicemen, and by 10 (ten) years for candidates belonging to (Physically Handicapped) category, whose disability should not be less than 40%.

Provided that, a candidate who comes under more than one category mentioned above, he/she will be eligible for only one age relaxation benefit, which shall be considered most beneficial to him/her.

SAVE AS PROVIDED ABOVE THE AGE LIMITS PRESCRIBED CAN IN NO CASE BE RELAXED.

Date of birth entered in the High School Certificate or equivalent certificate issued by the concerned Board/Council will only be accepted by the Commission.

4. **EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:**

Minimum educational qualification for the post of lecturer in Homoeopathic subjects (Subjects of Paper-1 contained in Appendix-A)

(a) A candidate must have possessed Post Graduate degree in Homoeopathy in the concerned subject from an University recognised by Central Council of Homoeopathy.

(b) **Minimum educational qualification for the post of lecturer in Allied Medical subject (Subjects of Paper-II contained in Appendix-A):** A candidate must have possessed Post Graduate Degree in Homoeopathy from an University recognised by Central Council of Homoeopathy.

5. **MAIN JOB CHART:**

To impart teaching to BHMS / P.G students

6. **APPLICATION FEE:**

A candidate is required to pay a non-refundable and non-adjustable fee of Rs.300/- (Rupees Three hundred) only. Candidate belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe of Odisha and persons with disability (whose disability is not less than 40%) are exempted from payment of this fee.

7. METHOD OF SELECTION:

The selection of candidates for recruitment to the post of Lecturer in Homeopathy shall be made on the basis of written test and career marking.

- (i) The Career marking will be for 30% (10% each for class 10th class, 12th and BHMS) and 70% for written test .

The plan of written test and broad outlines of the syllabus are appended at Appendix-A.

- (ii) (a) There shall be a common written test for selection to all posts and a common merit list shall be prepared by the Commission only for Allied subjects.
- (b) Allotment of subjects among the successful candidates shall be made subject to their option and position in the merit list.
- (c) For the four Homoeopathic subjects selection shall be made among the candidates having P.G. Degree in the subject concerned. However candidates having P.G. Degree in any of these four Homoeopathic subjects can also exercise their option for allied Homoeopathic subjects.

8. PLACE OF EXAMINATION:-

The written examination will be held at Cuttack.

9. OTHER ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:

- (i) The candidate must be a citizen of India;
- (ii) The candidate must have good character. The candidate must have sound health, good physique, active habits and free from organic defects or bodily/mental infirmity.
- (iii) Knowledge in Odia: He must be able to read, write and Speak Odia and have:-
- (a) Passed Middle School examination with Odia as a language subject; or
- (b) Passed matriculation or equivalent examination with Odia as a medium of Examination in non language subject; or
- (c) Passed in Odia as a language subject in the final examination of class –VII from a School or educational institution recognised by the Government of Odisha or Central Government; or
- (d) Passed a test in Odia in Middle English School Standard conducted by the school & Mass Education Department.
- (iv) A candidate, who has more than one spouse living, will not be eligible for appointment unless the State Government has exempted his/her case from operation of this limitation for any good and sufficient reasons;
- (v) Government servants / In-service Homoeopathic doctors whether temporary or permanent, are eligible to apply provided that they possess the requisite qualification and are within the prescribed age-limit as provided under para-3 & 4 of the Advertisement. **They must inform their respective Heads of Offices in writing regarding submission of their applications for this recruitment and obtained “No Objection Certificate”.**
- (vi) If a candidate has at any time, been debarred for a certain period/ chance(s) by the Odisha Public Service Commission or other State Public Service Commission or U.P.S.C. from appearing at any examination/ interview, he/she will not be eligible for such recruitment for that specified period/chance(s);

- (vii) **Only those candidates, who fulfil the requisite qualification & within the prescribed age limit and other eligibility conditions by the last date of filling up online application, will be considered eligible.**
- (viii) A candidate who claims change in his/her name after having passed the High School Certificate Examination or equivalent examination, is required to furnish copy of publication of the changed name in local leading daily news paper as well as copy of notification in the Odisha Gazette in support of his/her change of name.
- (ix) Every candidate selected for appointment shall be examined by the Medical Board. A candidate, who fails to satisfy the Medical Board, shall not be appointed;
- (x) Before appointment a candidate must have registered himself/ herself under the state Board of Homoeopathic Medicines, Odisha.

10. OTHER CONDITIONS:

- (i) The provisions of the Odisha Conduct of Examination Act 1988 (Odisha Act-2 of 1988) are applicable to the examination conducted by the Odisha Public Service Commission.
- (ii) A candidate found guilty of seeking support for his/her candidature by offering illegal gratification or applying pressure on any person connected with the conduct of the recruitment process or found indulging in any type of malpractice in course of the selection or otherwise, shall, in addition to rendering himself/herself liable to criminal prosecution, be disqualified not only for the recruitment for which he/she is a candidate, but also may be debarred, either permanently or for a specified period, from any recruitment or selection to be conducted by the Commission;
- (iii) **Applications submitted to OPSC if found to be incomplete in any respect are liable to rejection without entertaining any correspondence with the applicants on that score;**
- (iv) Admission to examination will be **provisional**. If on verification at any stage before or after the examination, it is found that a candidate does not fulfil all the eligibility conditions, his/her candidature will be liable to rejection. Decision of the Commission in regard to eligibility or otherwise of candidate shall be final.
- (v) This advertisement should not be construed as binding on the Government to make appointment;
- (vi) Concessions meant for S.C., S.T. and S.E.B.C by Birth are admissible to the Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and Socially Educationally Backward Classes of Odisha only.
- (vii) Candidates are required to take due care to annex with the copy of the printout/hard copy of online applications, the copies of certificates and other requisite documents as stated under Para-11 of this advertisement.
- (viii) All persons appointed under the Government of Odisha on or after 1st January, 2005 shall not be eligible for pension as defined under sub-rule(1) of Rule-3 of the Odisha Civil Service (Pension) Rules, 1992; but shall be covered by the new structure defined Contribution Pension Scheme in accordance with the Odisha civil Services (Pension) Amendment Rules, 2005;
- (ix) Any misrepresentation or suppression of information by the candidate in the online application form or in the hard copy of application will result in cancellation of his/her candidature or penalty, as decided by the Commission.
- (x) Mere empanelment in the select list shall not confer any right for appointment unless the Government is satisfied after making such enquiry as may be deemed necessary that the candidate is suitable in all respects for appointment to the service.

11. CERTIFICATES/DOCUMENTS TO BE ATTACHED:

Candidates are required to submit along with the printout/Hard copy of online applications, true copies of the following certificates and documents duly attested by the candidate or a Gazetted Officer or Notary public .The candidates are also required to mention on each document “submitted by me” and put their full signature on the same. **They must not attach original certificates with their applications.**

Only those candidates who qualify in the written examination will be required to bring with them the original certificates, mark sheets etc. of the attested copies for verification on the date fixed by the Commission. **If a candidate fails to furnish any of the original certificates and documents in respect of the attested copies submitted with the application by him /her for verification on the date fixed by the commission his/her candidature will be rejected.**

- (i) H.S.C. or equivalent certificate in support of declaration of age issued by the Concerned Board/Council;
- (ii) Intermediate/+2 Examination Certificate issued by the concerned Board / Council;
- (iii) B.H.M.S. Degree Certificate issued by the concerned University;
- (iv) P.G. Degree certificate issued by the concerned University
- (v) Mark-lists in support of all the aforesaid Examinations i.e. H.S.C. to P.G. Degree passed including fail marks, if any, issued by the concerned Board / Council /University

NOTE:-

- (a) Candidates who have not been awarded percentage of marks, but only “GRADE MARKS”, should, along with their applications, produce the conversion certificate from the concerned University indicating the actual equivalent percentage of marks and the conversion formula failing which, their applications are liable to be rejected.
- (b) While filling up the relevant box of the online application form, the candidate has to mention details of mark secured in each Annual examination leading to award of P.G. Degrees.
- (vi) Two recent passport size photographs (unsigned & unattested) which has been uploaded with online application form.
- (vii) Housemanship Completion Certificate;
- (viii) Medical Registration Certificate under the Odisha State Board of Homoeopathic Medicine.
- (ix) OPSC copy of Challan showing payment examination fees wherever applicable.
- (x) Certificates of conduct from the Principal/Proctor/Dean or Professor in charge of Teaching Department of the College or University in which he/she last studied;
- (xi) Caste Certificate by birth in support of claim as S.C. /S.T./S.E.B.C. Wherever applicable (Please see Note-1).

- (xii) Required Odia pass certificate from the Board of Secondary Education, Odisha indicating Odia as a language subject equivalent to M.E. School Standard or a certificate from the Principal/ Headmaster of the School indicating that the candidate has passed Odia in M.E. Standard; if not passed Odia as a subject in the HSC Exam/Equivalent Exam.
- (xiii) Discharge Certificates issued by the Commanding Officer of the Unit last served wherever applicable:
- (xiv) Disability Certificate (indicating percentage of disability) issued by the concerned Medical Board, wherever applicable;
- (xv) If a candidate claims to possess qualification, equivalent to the prescribed qualification, the rule/authority (with number and date) under which it is so treated, must be furnished with the application form.

NOTE 1:

Candidates claiming to be belonging to S.C./S.T./S.E.B.C Categories of Odisha by birth are required to submit copy of the relevant Caste Certificate issued by the competent authority in the prescribed form. Candidates of SEBC category (other than Creamy Layer) must submit copy of Caste Certificate issued by the competent authority within the last three years from the date of issue of the advertisement.

- (i) Women candidates belonging to S.C. /S.T. /S.E.B.C Categories are required to submit Caste Certificates by birth showing “daughter of” Caste Certificates by virtue of marriage (i.e. showing “wife of”) is not acceptable and candidates submitting such certificate will be treated as belonging to U.R. category.
- (ii) **OBC. CERTIFICATES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED IN LIEU OF SEBC CERTIFICATES.**
- (iii) Candidates who submit S.E.B.C. certificate which is more than three years old as on the date of advertisement will be treated as belonging to U.R. category.
- (iv) Community (Caste status) once mentioned by the candidates in the online application shall not be changed under any Circumstances.

The competent authorities are: District Magistrate/ Collector or Additional District Magistrate or Sub-divisional Magistrate/Sub-Collectors or Executive Magistrates or Revenue Officers, not below the rank of Tahasildar /Additional Tahasildar of Government of Odisha;

NOTE 2:

Degree Certificate, P.G. Degree certificate. Caste Certificate, Odia Test Pass Certificate, Discharge Certificate of Ex-servicemen, Sports certificate and Disability certificate of Physically Handicapped Persons must have been issued by the competent authority before the last date fixed for receipt of application as indicated above.

12. HOW TO APPLY

- (a) Candidates must go through details of this Advertisement before filling up the online application form.
- (b) Candidates must apply online through the website of OPSC <http://opsconline.gov.in>. Applications received through any other mode would not be accepted and be summarily rejected.

- (c) Before filling up the online application form, the candidates must go through the following documents available at OPSC portal.
- i) Instructions to fill up the online application form;
 - ii) Guidelines for scanning and Uploading of Photograph, Full signature and Left Thumb Impression.
- (d) Candidates are required to upload the scanned image of latest passport size photograph along with scanned image of his/her full signature and scanned image of Left Thumb Impression (LTI) in the Online Application Form. **The uploaded photograph, full signature and LTI must be clearly identifiable/visible, otherwise the application of the candidate is liable to be rejected** by the Commission and no representation from the candidate will be entertained.
- (e) Candidates should keep at least 2 copies of the latest passport size photograph which is uploaded on the online application form for future use.
- (f) **On successful submission of the Online Application Form, a Unique Registration ID will be displayed on the screen as well as on the top of the application form. Candidates are required to take a printout of the finally submitted online application form and put his/her signature under the Declaration for submission to O.P.S.C. along with copies of requisite certificates and documents**
- (g) **Thereafter, the candidates who are required to pay the fee shall take a printout of Online Challan (Pay-in-Slip) for payment of requisite fee of Rs. 300/- (Three hundred) only at any branch of State Bank of India (SBI). The Fee paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances nor can the fee be adjusted or held in reserve for any other examination or recruitment.**
- (h) Candidates are required to send the Printout/Hard copy of the filled in Online Application Form duly signed under the declaration along with copies of required certificates and documents etc., as provided under para-11 of this Advertisement and the OPSC copy of Challan showing payment of Application Fee, by Registered Post/Speed Post to the Special Secretary, Odisha Public Service Commission, 19, Dr. P.K. Parija Road, Cuttack -753001 so as to reach the same in the office of the OPSC on or before **25.05.2015**.
- The envelope containing the printout/hard copy of the Online Application along with copies of requisite certificates and documents etc. must be superscribed "APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF LECTURERS IN HOMOEOPATHIC MEDICAL COLLEGES OF THE STATE". Application received after the closing date shall not be entertained. The Commission will not take any responsibility if the Application is not received in time.
- (i) The candidates are advised to submit the Online Application Form well in advance without waiting for the closing date to avoid last hour rush.'

- (j) Certificate of admission to the examination to the eligible candidates will be uploaded in the website of the OPSC prior to the date of examination which will be published in the website and news paper. The candidates are required to download their Admission Certificate from the website of the Commission and produce the same for admission to the examination. No separate correspondence will be made on this score.



APPENDIX-A
Syllabus of Examination

Subject for written examination for recruitment to the post of Lecturers in different disciplines of Government Homoeopathic Medical Colleges.

The written examination shall be of two papers carrying 150 marks each with a duration of one and half hour for each paper. The questions will be as per Bachelor in Homoeopathic Medicine and Surgery curriculum. The questions will be objective type of multiple choice (100 questions of one and half mark each) on the following subjects.

Paper-I (Homeopathic Subjects)

(a)	Materia Medica	:	40 marks
(b)	Organon of Medicine	:	40 marks
(c)	Repertory	:	40 marks
(d)	Homoeopathic Pharmacy	:	30 marks

Paper-II (Allied Subjects)

(a)	Practice of Medicine	:	30 marks
(b)	Obstetrics & Gynaecology	:	20 marks
(c)	Surgery	:	20 marks
(d)	Community Medicine	:	20 marks

(f)	Pathology	:	20 marks
