Applications on the prescribed form are invited from the eligible candidates for the following posts shown against the subjects to be filled up in Himachal Pradesh University. Interested candidates may submit their applications, complete in all respects, along with fee to the 'Deputy Registrar, Recruitment Branch, Himachal Pradesh University, Summer Hill, Shimla (Himachal Pradesh) PIN-171005' so as to reach on or before **28th February, 2017** (Tuesday upto 04:00 p.m.). However, for the candidates residing in Andman and Nicobar Islands, Lakshadweep, Ladakh Division of J&K State, Assam, Tripura, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram, Arunchal Pradesh, Pangi and Bharmour Sub Division of Chamba District, , Dodra Kwar Sub Division of Shimla District, Kinnaur District and Lahul & Spiti District of Himachal Pradesh, the last date for receipt of application by post/speed post (Not by hand or by Courier) is 15th March, 2017. Applications received after the last date will not be considered. The University will not be responsible for postal delay, if any.

2. Educational Qualifications:

Essential/Desirable Qualifications, pay-scale, Experience and other eligibility conditions as per the norms prescribed by the UGC as amended from time to time, adopted by Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla from time to time and service conditions and other allowances as per rules & regulations of Himachal Pradesh University. However, educational qualifications for recruitment of teachers in the Faculty of Education, the norms/ Regulations formulated in consultation with National Council for Teacher Education; for Faculty of Engineering and Technology & Management/ Business Administration, the norms/ Regulations formulated in consultations with All India Council for Technical Education, shall apply as per provisions under clause 1.1.1 of UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and Other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education-2010. 3. Parameters for Selection:

(A) Professor / Director/ Associate Professor:

All eligible candidates as per minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS), set out in the UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and Other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education-2010 as amended from time to time shall be invited for interviews. Selection shall be based on analysis of the merits and credentials of the applicants based on weightages given to the performance of the candidate in different relevant dimensions and his/her performance on a scoring system proforma, based on the Academic Performance Indicator (API) as provided in the UGC Regulations- 2010.

(B) Assistant Professor:

Selection shall be done from amongst the eligible candidates on the basis of a marks system having a total of 100 marks. These marks shall be distributed between two components as follows:

(ii) **The Interview Component (20 marks):**

The 20 marks for the interview shall be distributed as follows:

Marks for competence in subject: 10

Marks for communication ability: 10

(iii) **Short Listing for interview:**

- (a) The qualification and experiences prescribed are the minimum and mere possession of the same shall not entitle a candidate to be called for interview.

- (b) The shortlisted candidates shall be invited for an interview in order of merit according to marks obtained by them in the Scholastic Attainment Component i.e. for one vacancy maximum of 15 (fifteen) candidates shall be invited. For every additional vacancy a maximum of 10 additional eligible candidates shall be invited.
- (c) Candidates called for interview shall have to essentially come with the original documents in support of their claim in application form and as prescribed in interview letter, failing which they shall not be considered for interview. No T.A./D.A. will be paid for attending interview.
- (iv) Selection:**
- (a) The marks obtained by each candidate in the Tally Sheet as well as in the interview shall be added up and the total thus obtained shall determine the candidate's rank on the merit list for appointment. A candidate must have obtained a minimum of 10 marks in the interview to be placed on the final merit list.
- (b) The Selection Committee shall always have the right to determine that none of the candidates were found fit for selection and recommend that the post(s) be re-advertised.

4. Application Form:

The Prescribed application form can be downloaded from the University website <http://www.hpuniv.nic.in> and <http://www.hpuniv.in>. Separate applications are to be filled for each post. The in-service candidates must send their applications through proper channel. However, an advance copy with fee may be sent so as to reach before the last date. The completed application forms along with self attested photocopies of claims made in application and applicable fee should reach **Deputy Registrar, Recruitment Branch, Himachal Pradesh University, Summer Hill, Shimla – 171005 (HP)** through Registered/Speed post or by hand before the last date failing which it will not be considered.

5. Fee:

Application processing fee for General category candidates is Rs. 1000/- and for SC of HP/ST of HP/OBC of HP is Rs.500/- which is required to paid alongwith application form in the shape of crossed Indian Postal Orders/ Bank draft drawn in favour of Finance Officer, Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla payable at Shimla. The candidates can also pay requisite application processing fee in cash at the fee counter of Himachal Pradesh University, Summer Hill, Shimla (Fee Code: P3240). Visual Handicapped candidates of HP are exempted from fee. The application processing fee once paid will not be refunded (Full or partial) under any circumstances.


Note: (*) Those candidates, who have applied earlier in response to advertisement No. Rectt.-1/2014 dated 08/09/2014 shall apply afresh and submit the completed application on the prescribed proforma with necessary documents and additional application processing fee of Rs.600/- along with the application form. Their

eligibility and other terms and conditions shall be considered on the last date of receipt of application form *ibid*. Such candidate(s) may produce valid proof of having deposited the fee with the University earlier.

6. General Instructions:

- (i) The application form should be filled in by the candidate in his/her own handwriting with blue/ black ink ball point pen.
- (ii) A person applying for more than one post should send separate application form for each post.
- (iii) The Candidates must fulfil the required essential educational qualification(s)/ experience and other conditions on the last date fixed for receipt of application forms.
- (iv) Incomplete applications, e.g., declaration not signed, without photo and enclosures and columns not filled in or applications received after the last date shall be rejected summarily without assigning any reason.
- (v) In-service candidates shall be required to produce the N.O.C. from the concerned Department at the time of personal interview.
- (vi) Advantage of reservation for SC/ST/OBC/PH category will be provided only to the candidates belonging to state of H.P. only. Reserved category candidates, who are domicile out of Himachal Pradesh State, will be treated as open category candidates.
- (vii) Any candidate found to have given false/wrong declaration, he/she will be debarred from employment in the University, and shall also be liable for other legal action under the law.
- (viii) No change of category shall be allowed after receipt of application, i.e., from SC to OBC/ST and vice-versa.
- (ix) Any addendum/ dedendum/ corrigendum/ notices shall be posted on the University's website only.
- (x) The University reserves the right to fill up or not to fill up the post(s) or to call limited candidates for test/interview. The University also reserves the right to fill up these posts either on regular basis or on contract basis. The number of posts likely to be filled up may vary.


