**1. Applications are invited till 5.00 PM of 20/12/2017** from the practicing Advocates who, (a) Must be holder of degree in law granted by a recognized University established by law in India, (b) Must be practicing as an advocate in Courts of Civil and Criminal jurisdiction on the last date for receipt of applications and must have so practiced for a period of not less than 5 (five) years as on the last date fixed for receipt of applications; (c) Must not have completed, as on the last date fixed for receipt of applications 40 years of age in the case of candidates belonging to Arunachal Pradesh Schedules Tribes for filling up of **2(two) vacancies (reserved for APST candidates) in Grade-II of Arunachal Pradesh Judicial Service** in the scale of pay of Rs. 39530-920-40450-1080-49090-1230-54010/- per month plus other allowances as admissible under the Rules.

**2.** Same as otherwise provided in the Arunachal Pradesh Judicial Service Rules, 2006 (as amended) relating to relaxation of age for reserved category candidates, 80% of the posts to be filled up by direct recruitment is reserved for candidates belonging to Arunachal Pradesh Scheduled Tribes (APST) and 20% of the posts is unreserved.

**3.** No person shall be eligible for appointment to the service (a) unless he is a citizen of India: (b) if he has been dismissed from service by any High Court, Government or Statutory or local authority; (c) if he has been convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude or who is or has been permanently debarred or disqualified by the High Court or the Union Public Service Commission or any State Public Service Commission from appearing in any examination or selection conducted by it; (d) if he directly or indirectly influences the recruiting authority by any means for his candidature and (e) if he/she has more than one spouse living.

**4.** The duly filled in application form in the prescribed format along with all testimonials should reach The Registrar, The Gauhati High Court, Itanagar Permanent Bench, Naharlagun, Arunachal Pradesh, PIN- 791110 on or before the last date fixed for

  
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receipt of application form. The envelope containing the application form and documents should be super scribed as "Application for direct recruitment to Grade-II of APJS, 2017".

5. Self-attested photocopies of documents in proof of his/her educational qualifications, Certificate of Enrollment as an advocate, Age, Certificate of Practice, Caste Certificate etc. and 4 (four) copies of recent passport size photographs should be submitted along with the application form.

6. The envelope containing the application form and documents may be sent by post or the same may be dropped in the Drop Box kept in the premises of Itanagar Permanent Bench, Gauhati High Court, Naharlagun, Arunachal Pradesh, PIN-791110 during office hours. No application will be received / accepted after the last date fixed for receipt of application forms. The High Court shall not be responsible for postal delay etc.

7. Indian Postal Order (IPO) of Rs. 200/- (rupees two hundred) (only for APST candidates), payable to The Registrar, Gauhati High Court, Itanagar Permanent Bench, Naharlagun, Arunachal Pradesh, PIN-791110 should be enclosed with the application form.

8. **The candidates will have to appear in a Preliminary Examination (Screening test) of objective questions of 100 marks (2 hour duration), which will cover English, General Knowledge, Aptitude, , Constitution of India, Code of Civil Procedure, Transfer of Property Act, Indian Contract Act, Indian Penal Code, Code of Criminal Procedure, Indian Evidence Act and Law of Torts.** From the rank wise list of marks of the Preliminary Examination, 10 (ten) candidates will be called against 1 vacancy (1:10) for the Final Written Examination. However, the High Court reserves the right to fix cut off mark in the Preliminary Examination and call only those candidates to appear in the Final Written Examination who obtain the cut off mark as may be fixed by the High Court.

9. All candidates who obtain 50 (fifty) percent or more marks or corresponding grade in the Final Written Examination shall be eligible for viva-voce of 70 (seventy) marks. This would be subject to the ratio of 1:3 of the rank wise list of marks obtained by the candidates in the Final Written Examination. In the viva-voce, out of 70 (seventy) marks the candidates will have to secure minimum 60% marks. Selection of candidates

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shall be made on the basis of marks obtained in the Final Written Examination and viva-voce, subject to the cut off mark indicated above. However, the final selection shall be made subject to overall suitability to be decided by the High Court.

**10.** The candidates shall have to appear in a final written examination consisting of the following papers;

**Paper-I: English (100 marks)**

- a) Essay Writing
- b) Précis Writing
- c) Grammar etc.

**Paper- II: General Knowledge (100 marks)**

- a) Objective Type
- b) Aptitude Test

**Paper- III: Law Paper – I (100 marks)**

- a) Constitution of India
- b) Code of Civil Procedure
- c) Transfer of Property Act
- d) Indian Contract Act

**Paper- IV: Law Paper-II (100 marks)**

- a) Indian Penal Code
- b) Code of Criminal Procedure
- c) Indian Evidence Act
- d) Law of Torts

**Note: The candidates are expected to refer to the relevant decisions of the Apex Court and the High Court while writing answers in Paper III and IV.**

**11.** Detail scrutiny of the applications will be made after the declaration of the result of the final written examination. Hence the candidature of the applicants will be subject to furnishing true & correct information against the fields indicated in the application form and fulfillment of the criteria mentioned in the advertisement. Suppression of any material facts and submission of any false documents will be entirely at the peril of the candidate.

**12.** The candidates shall have to appear in the written examinations / interview at their own expenses as and when called for.

**13.** Application submitted not as per the advertisement shall be summarily rejected.


**14.** Candidates claiming relaxation as PWD (Person with Disability) need not deposit application fees. Certificate claiming relaxation as person with disability is required to submit the certificate as enclosed with this advertisement at appropriate stage.

**15. TERMS AND CONDITIONS:**

- i.** Merely satisfying the eligibility criteria do not entitle a candidate to be called for the written examination/ interview etc.
- ii.** No person, who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living or who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts.
- iii.** The admission of candidates at all stages of the selection process will be purely provisional and subject to their satisfying the prescribed eligibility criteria. If, on verification at any time before or after the selection process, it is found that a candidate does not fulfill any of the eligibility conditions, his/her candidature shall stand cancelled without any notice. Mere calling of candidate to written test/ interview etc. or issuance of admit card / call letter etc. does not necessarily mean acceptance of candidature of any candidate which shall be further scrutinized at every stage and the High Court reserves the right to reject the candidature of any candidate at any time.
- iv.** Submission of application does not imply that a candidate has fulfilled all the criteria given in the advertisement and application is subject to subsequent scrutiny and the application can be rejected at any subsequent point of time, if any ineligibility condition is detected at any point of time.
- v.** The list of the candidates, with allotted Roll Nos. will be published in the High Court website for the candidates' reference.
- vi.** No TA/DA shall be paid to the candidates for appearing in the written test/interview etc.
- vii.** Application form, which is incomplete in any respect, such as without the photograph and signature, is liable to be rejected summarily, unless otherwise decided by the High Court.

  
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- viii. Any information submitted by an applicant in his/her application will bind the candidate personally.
- ix. The candidate will be responsible for any mistake made by him/her in the application form.
- x. The certificate for claim of reservation must have been issued by the competent authority.
- xi. The appointment and conditions of service of the selected candidates shall be governed by the Judicial Service Rules.
- xii. **If any candidate is found canvassing directly or indirectly, his/her candidature will be rejected.**
- xiii. The High Court reserves the right to cancel the advertisement, alter any terms and conditions of the advertisement at any stage.
- xiv. The examination materials will be destroyed, due to scarcity of space, after one year of publication of the final select list, unless otherwise decided by the High Court.
- xv. All other matters which are not specifically provided in this advertisement shall be as decided by the High Court.
