


**Notice for Summer Internship for
Undergraduate Engineering Student's - 2018 at
Technical Training Centre, Diesel Locomotive Works, Varanasi-221004**

1. Technical Training Centre (TTC), Diesel Locomotive Works (DLW), Varanasi will conduct Vocational Training for the Undergraduates of Engineering (Degree / Diploma) students. The duration of the internship shall not be more than 6 weeks.
2. The application forms shall be filled online by website www.dlw.indianrailways.gov.in starts from **26.02.2018** and closing for online registration is **05.03.2018**.
3. Before filling the online form, students must have the scanned copy (soft copy) in jpeg format of documents as detailed below:

4. Student must submit fully filled form at address given below by post/courier/by hand :



5. Last date of submission of hard copy of form is 15.03.2018.
6. List of eligible candidates will be uploaded on DLW website upto 23.03.2018.
7. Training date and training area shall be allotted at the time of reporting for training by TTC.
8. It is advised to students to keep the photocopy of all papers and bring at the time of reporting for training.
9. Facilities of internships will be offered to only those candidates who are still studying at Undergraduate level in Technical / Engineering areas and not to those who have passed the final examination and have left the Institution.
10. No fee would be charged from trainees.
11. No remuneration in the form of stipend, salary or allowances of any kind will be paid to the trainees by the DLW administration. No passes or PTOs will be issued to them.
12. The trainees will have to conform to all General rules and regulations of discipline and conduct during Vocational Training / Internship at the DLW Administration.

14. Seats may be increased or decreased by the competent authority (Principal/TTC).
15. Any loss or damage to equipment and fittings that may be caused by the trainee during the course of training in workshop etc. should be indemnified by the Parent/Guardian of the student.
16. *The trainees will not be treated as employees of the DLW and as such will not be entitled to any compensation or damages from the DLW for any injury to them or to their property etc.*
17. The trainees will be under the administrative control and discipline of the Principal, TTC/ DLW, Varanasi.
18. On successful completion of internship with minimum 80% attendance of working training days and on submission of project report (preferably in soft copy) by trainees, a certificate will be issued to them by TTC/DLW, Varanasi.
19. TTC/DLW may instruct an intern to terminate the training programme at any time, as deemed fit, without assigning any reason. The decision of the Principal, TTC/DLW shall be final in this regard. Also an intern can leave the programme, if he/she desires, giving prior notice of seven (07) working days to the controlling officer. *No certificate shall be awarded to such an intern.*



20. The internship course shall not confer any claim / right for any employment in any office / establishment under the administrative control of the Ministry of Railways / PSUs.
21. The training is imparted mainly in Mechanical, Electrical, Electronics, Computer Science, IT and Civil engineering.
22. The normal training period shall be 4 to 6 weeks, which may be extended up to 8 weeks on special request from institute and with approval of Principal, TTC, DLW, Varanasi. The duration of the internship shall not be more than 8 weeks.
23. Vocational trainees shall abide by all the statutory norms of Quality, Environment, Health and Safety Management Systems. In case of any accident or resultant casualties whatsoever during the training period, DLW cannot be held responsible under any circumstances. No trainee shall be allowed inside the workshop without Safety Shoes, Helmets and PPE's.
24. Photography in workshop premises is strictly prohibited.
25. The TTC/DLW administration's decision regarding enlisting the students for training will be final and binding. Any subsequent correspondence from students or Engineering College will not be entertained.
26. The trainees have to make their own arrangement for lodging and boarding.
27. Training Schedule and duration is conditional and subjective. TTC/DLW Administration may prepone, postpone, curtail and/or cancel the training on administrative grounds. All rights on the subject are reserved by TTC/DLW Administration.
28. No trainee shall be allowed inside the workshop training area or TTC campus except the time allotted in the Admit form / gate pass.
