HR AWARDS & ACCOLADES



- Candidates working with subsidiaries of Scheduled Commercial Banks will not be eligible to apply.
- Candidates working in SBI in clerical/ supervisory cadre or employees engaged on contract basis will not be eligible to apply.
- Candidates who have resigned from officer grade in SBI/Associate Banks or employees previously engaged on contract basis in SBI and resigned/exited from Bank will not be eligible to apply.

Important Note:

- Reservation for Person with Benchmark Disability (PwBD) candidates is horizontal and will be guided by various guidelines of Government of India.
- Vacancies reserved for OBC category are available to OBC candidates belonging to "Non-creamy layer". Candidates belonging to OBC category but coming in "CREAMY LAYER", are not entitled for any relaxation/ reservation available to OBC category. They should indicate their category as General OR General (LD/ VI/ HI/ d&e) as applicable.
- OBC category candidate should submit the OBC certificate on format prescribed by Govt. of India, having "Non-Creamy Layer" clause issued during period **01.04.2023** to the date of interview, if called for interview.
- Reservation for Economically Weaker Section (EWS) in recruitment is governed by Office Memorandum no. 36039/1/2019-Estt (Res) dt. 31.01.2019 of Department of Personnel & Training, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievance & Pensions, Government of India.
Disclaimer: "EWS vacancies are tentative and subject to further directives of Government of India and outcome of any litigation. The appointment is provisional and is subject to the Income & Asset certificate being verified through the proper channels."
- The EWS candidates are required to produce for verification the 'Income & Asset Certificate' issued based on gross annual income for the Financial Year 2022-23 as per extant DoPT guidelines, on the date of document verification at the time of interview. Hence the 'Income & Asset Certificate' issued based on gross annual income for the financial year 2022-23 must be obtained by the candidate on or before the date of document verification at the time of interview. **No request for extension of time for production of 'Income & Asset Certificate' beyond the said date** shall be entertained and if a candidate fails to produce the 'Income & Asset Certificate' on the date of document verification at the time of interview, he/ she will not be considered for appointment in the Bank for the post of Circle Based Officer.

1. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

(A) Essential Academic Qualifications:

Graduation in any discipline from a recognised University or any equivalent qualification recognised as such by the Central Government including Integrated Dual Degree (IDD). Candidates possessing qualifications such as Medical, Engineering, Chartered Accountant, Cost Accountant would also be eligible.

Note: The date of passing eligibility examination will be the date appearing on the mark sheet or provisional certificate issued by the University/ Institute. In case the result of a particular examination is posted on the website of the University/ Institute, a certificate issued by the appropriate authority of the University/ Institute indicating the date on which the result was posted on the website will be taken as the date of passing.

(B) Age Limit: (As on 31.10.2023):

Not below 21 years and Not above 30 years as on **31.10.2023** i.e. candidates must have been born not later than **31.10.2002** and not earlier than **01.11.1993 (both days inclusive)**.

(E) Other:

4% horizontal reservation has been provided under section 34 of "The Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016" suitable for the Persons with undernoted categories of RPwD Act 2016:

a) Blind, Low Vision
b) Hard of Hearing
c) One Arm, Both Arms, One Leg, Both Legs and One Leg, Cerebral Palsy, Leprosy Cured, Dwarfism, Acid Attacked Victims, Spinal Deformity (SD) and Spinal Injury (SI) without any neurological/ limb dysfunction.
d) Autism Spectrum Disorder (Mild)
e) Multiple Disabilities involving (a) to (d) and any other category

A. Visual Impairment (VI): Only those Visually Impaired candidates who have one of the following conditions, after best correction:

- Blindness:**
 - Total absence of sight; OR
 - Visual acuity less than 3/60 or less than 10 degrees of arc with possible correction; OR
 - Limitation of the field of vision subtending less than 10 degrees.
- Low Vision:**
 - Visual acuity not exceeding 6/18 (Snellen) in the better eye with best correction; OR
 - Limitation of the field of vision subtending less than 10 degrees.

B. Hearing Impaired (HI):

- Hard of Hearing:** means person having hearing loss in both ears.

C. Locomotor Disabilities (LD):

Only those persons are eligible to apply who have inability to execute distinctive movements of the body resulting from affliction of muscles, Cerebral Palsy, Leprosy Cured, Dwarfism, Spinal Deformity (SD) and Spinal Injury (SI) without any neurological/ limb dysfunction. Orthopedically challenged persons under Locomotor Disability:

- OA** - One arm affected (Right or Left)
- BA** - Both arms affected
- OL** - One leg affected (Right or Left)
- BL** - Both Leg affected
- OAL** - One Arm One Leg affected

Persons with OA, BA and OAL categories are eligible for appointment to the post.

- "Cerebral palsy"** means a Group of conditions which affect the body movements and muscle coordination.

A person who wants to avail benefit of reservation will have to submit a disability certificate issued by a Competent Authority **as per Government of India guidelines**. Such certificate will be subject to verification/ re-verification as may be decided by the competent authority. The certificate should be dated on or before last date of registration of application.

Guidelines for use of scribe & compensatory time:

a). The facility of scribe would be allowed to a person who has **disability of 40% or more** if so desired by the person and is meant for only those persons with disability who have physical limitation to write including that of speed. In all such cases where a scribe is used, the following rules will apply:

- Candidates eligible for and who wish to use the services of scribe in the examination should carefully indicate the same in the online application form. Any subsequent request may not be favorably entertained.
- Both the candidate and the scribe will have to give a suitable undertaking, in the prescribed format with passport size photograph of the scribe at the time of online examination.
- Such candidates who are eligible to use a scribe shall be eligible for compensatory time of 20 minutes for every hour of the examination whether availing the facility of scribe or not.
- Candidate will have to arrange his/ her/ their own scribe at his/ her/ their own cost.
- Any candidate who is not eligible to use scribe as per guidelines, as referred above, uses scribe in the online examination shall be disqualified to participate further in the process of recruitment, in addition to any other action that Bank may deem fit against the candidate and the scribe. Any candidate using scribe in violation of the above guidelines can be removed from the service without notice, if already joined the Bank.
- **During the examination, at any stage, If it is found that scribe is independently answering / solving the questions himself, the examination session for such candidate will be terminated, and candidate's candidature will be cancelled. The candidature of such candidates using the services of a scribe will also be cancelled if it is reported after the examination by the test administrator personnel that the scribe independently answered the questions.**
- The scribe arranged by the candidate should not be a candidate for the same online examination. If violation of the above is detected at any stage of process, candidature of both the candidate and the scribe will be cancelled.
- Scribe will be allowed to be used as per the guidelines issued vide Office Memorandum F.No.16-110/2003-DDIII dated February 26, 2013 of Government of India, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Department of Disability Affairs, New Delhi and clarification issued by Government of India, Ministry of Financial, Deptt. of Financial Services vide letter No. F. No. 3/2/2013-Welfare dated 26.04.2013.

b). Use of Scribe & Compensatory time (persons with specified disabilities covered under the definition of section 2(s) of the RPwD Act 2016 but not covered under the definition of section 2(r) of the said act, i.e persons having less than 40% disability and having difficulty in writing):

In terms of Office Memorandum F. No .29-6/2019-DD-III dated 10/08/2022 of Government of India, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment , Department of Empowerment of persons with Disabilities(Divyanganjan) , In addition to the instructions applicable to PwBD candidates (who have disability 40% or more) the facility of scribe and /or compensatory time shall be granted solely to the persons with disabilities covered under section 2(s) of the RPwD Act 2016 but not covered under the definition of section 2(r) of the said act (i.e persons having less than 40% disability and having difficulty in writing), to those having difficulty in writing, subject to **production of a certificate to the effect** that person concerned has limitation to write and that scribe is essential to write examination on his/ her behalf from the competent medical authority of a Government healthcare institution as per prescribed Proforma at Appendix-I of the said O.M. In case the candidate opts to bring his / her own scribe, the qualification of the scribe should be one step below the qualification of the candidate taking the examination. Candidate opting for own scribe should submit details of the own scribe as per Proforma at Appendix-II of the said O.M.

3. CATEGORY:

Instructions for writing Category Name & Code no. while applying online.

PLEASE NOTE THAT CHANGE OF CATEGORY WILL NOT BE PERMITTED AT ANY STAGE AFTER REGISTRATION OF ONLINE APPLICATION.

Candidates belonging to OBC category but coming in the 'CREAMY LAYER', are not entitled to OBC reservation and age relaxation. They should indicate their category as 'GEN' or 'GEN (LD)' or 'GEN (VI)' or GEN (HI) or GEN (d&e) (as applicable).

Benefit of reservation under EWS category can be availed upon production of an 'Income and Asset Certificate' issued by a Competent Authority on the format prescribed by Government

(b). Screening:

Online application and documents of candidates placed before the Screening Committee.

The Screening Committee constituted by the Bank will check the required eligibility criteria of experience of candidates submitted by the candidates (certified by the Bank if they are/were employed) with the job profile of the candidates of State Bank of India. In case their job profile does not match with the job profile of Scale-I Generalist Officer of State Bank of India, they will be summarily rejected. **Bank may decide the eligibility of candidates matching the Job Profile of the candidates of State Bank of India. The decision of the Bank will be final and no representation or correspondence will be entertained.**

Merit list will be drawn Circle wise and Category wise. Candidates who scored in Online Test for candidates who failed in the Screening Committee. Candidates number of vacancies and Category wise vacancies, subject to availability of vacancies and interview from the top of the merit list drawn. Mere qualifying in online exam will not vest the candidates with the right to be interviewed.

(c). Interview:

Interview will consist of 50 marks. Candidates who are not qualified in interview to be considered for final selection will be notified by the Bank.

Candidates qualifying for interview under 'Non-Creamy Layer' category but certificate containing the 'Non-Creamy Layer' category and who have declared themselves as OBC but do not submit OBC certificate will not be eligible for interview under General category will not be considered for interview.

Candidates qualifying for interview under 'Creamy Layer' category but certificate issued based on gross annual income exceeding the limit specified in the guidelines. Candidates who have registered for interview but do not submit certificate issued based on gross annual income exceeding the limit specified in the guidelines and request for interview under Category wise will not be considered for interview.

Final Selection:

The candidates will have to qualify both in Online Test and Interview. The marks obtained in Online Test and Interview will be added to obtain the total marks. The marks obtained in Interview for preparation of merit list will be prepared based on normalization of marks of Online Test and Interview weightage respectively.

Marks secured by the candidates in the Online Test and Interview of 75 marks and Interview scores of candidates will be added to obtain the total marks. The final merit list (Circle wise and Category wise) of 100) converted marks of Online Test and Interview will be ranked candidates in merit list prepared on the basis of total marks.

Result Publication:

Results of candidates called for Interview, will be published on the Bank's website.

Final selection will be subject to Qualifying marks and other conditions applicable, as detailed above.

5. EXAMINATION CENTERS:

- The examinations will be conducted on the basis of tentative list of centres for Online Examination.
- No request for change of Examination Center will be entertained.**
- SBI reserves the right to cancel any centre if the number of candidates is less than the prescribed number.

9. PRE-EXAMINATION TRAINING:

Bank will arrange pre-examination training (PET) in online mode for SC/ ST/ OBC/Religious Minority Community candidates in consonance with the guidelines issued by Government of India. All eligible candidates who opt for and wish to avail of Pre-Examination Training should fill in the relevant column in the ON-LINE APPLICATION. An indicative list of training centers is given as Annexure-II. Bank may add additional centers or may delete some of the centers indicated for training. Candidates opting for pre-examination training should download their call letter for training from Bank's website by entering their registration number and password/ date of birth. No hard copy of the call letter will be sent.

10. HOW TO APPLY:

Candidates can apply online only from **22.11.2023** to **12.12.2023**. No other mode of application will be accepted.

Pre-requisites for Applying Online: Candidates should have valid email ID and mobile no. which should be kept active till the declaration of final results. It will be essentially required for receiving any communication/ call letters/ advices from the bank by email/ SMS.

b. Guidelines for scanning the documents, photograph & signature:

Guidelines for scanning and Uploading of Signature/ Photograph/ Documents

Before applying online, a candidate will be required to keep ready a scanned (digital) image of his/ her photograph, signature and documents as per the specifications given below.

a. Signature:

- i. The applicant must sign on white paper with Black Ink pen.
- ii. The signature must be signed only by the applicant and not by any other person.
- iii. The signature will be used to put on the Call Letter and wherever necessary.
- iv. If the applicant's signature on the answer script, at the time of the examination, does not match the signature on the Call Letter, the applicant will be disqualified.
- v. Size of file should be between 10 - 20 kb & Dimensions 140 x 60 pixels (preferably).
- vi. Ensure that the size of the scanned image is not more than 20 kb.
